


# Major Keys





## Flats

If you can remember everything is just "5" letter names away, all you have to remember is the letter "C". Once you have "C", go 5 letter names to the left and add 1 flat. The order of flats start with "B $\flat$ ".


## Sharps

If you can remember everything is just "5" letter names away, all you have to remember is the letter "C". Once you have "C", go 5 letter names to the right and add 1 sharp. The order of sharps start with "F $\sharp$ ".




# Minor Keys

Remember the minor key is 3 letter names below the major

## Flats



If you can remember everything is just "5" letter names away, all you have to remember is the letter "a". Once you have "a", go 5 letter names to the left and add 1 flat. The order of flats start with "Bb".



## Sharps

If you can remember everything is just "5" letter names away, all you have to remember is the letter "a". Once you have "a", go 5 letter names to the right and add 1 sharp. The order of sharps start with "F#".
